SUBJECT: Kunsan AB Health Monitoring Status Procedures

1. You have been identified as meeting the requirements for Kunsan Air Base Health Monitoring Status. During Health monitoring status, fully vaccinated individuals may travel from domicile to duty as well as perform mission essential activities.
2. Members in Health Monitoring Status can:
 - a. CONDUCT ALL DUTY ACTIVITIES: including combined training and exercises on USFK & ROK MND installations
 - b. PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION only to accomplish MISSION ESSENTIAL activities
 - c. HEALTH, LIFE AND SAFETY ACTIVITIES emergency services, hospitals/health care providers/pharmacies, child care, gas stations, banks/money exchange/realtor
 - d. PURCHASING FOOD, CLOTHING AND ESSENTIAL NEEDS at retail stores, convenience stores, grocery stores, and markets (indoor malls & department stores prohibited)
 - e. TAKE-OUT, DELIVERY AND DRIVE-THRU FROM RESTAURANTS
 - f. LODGING IN APPROVED LOCATIONS lodging location must be pre-approved by USFK, GOVT, or Component Commander.
 - g. OUTDOOR HIKE, WALK, BIKE, RUN (FOLLOW ROK RULES ON GROUP SIZES)
3. Members will be tested three times while in Health Monitoring Status. Personnel will be tested for COVID upon arrival as their Day 1 test, again on Day 6/7, and finally on Day 12 to enable-exit from Health Monitoring Status on Day 14. After completion of the entire 14-day monitoring period with no symptoms or positive tests, the restrictions will be lifted. Individuals will be released by their chain of command after notification by Public Health of a negative Day 12 test result.
4. All members who desire to enter Health Monitoring Status must provide their commander with a Quarantine Action Plan. See attachment 35 Quarantine Action Plan Template.
5. Any deviations from the above procedures must be routed as an Exception to Policy through the member's chain of command to be approved by the installation commander.
6. Any questions regarding this memorandum will be directed to your change of command.
