MEMORANDUM FOR INDIVIDUALS SUBJECT TO MEDICAL QUARANTINE

FROM: 8 FW/PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY OFFICER (PHEO)

SUBJECT: Kunsan AB Medical Off Base Quarantine Guidance

1. In response to the declared public health emergency on Kunsan AB, all travelers in USFK custody must complete a quarantine or Health Monitoring Status for a minimum of 14 days.

3. Rules of Engagement:

- a **LOCATION:** You may NOT leave your quarantine location unless there is an immediate concern for your safety. **Individuals quarantined off base are NOT authorized outdoor time and may not take out their trash or smoke outdoors during the duration of their quarantine.** Individuals in Health Monitoring Status must adhere to all guidance included in the Kunsan AB Health Monitoring Status Procedures MFR. All individuals conducting quarantine or Health Monitoring Status off base must follow all ROKG quarantine restrictions and should contact Gunsan Public Health at 063-463-4000 if they have questions.

b **TESTING REQUIREMENTS:** Personnel quarantining off base, to include non-active duty TRICARE beneficiaries IAW the 8 MDG Space Available Policy Memo, may receive quarantine COVID-19 testing at the 8 MDG, but may receive a bill for these services.

c **SYMPTOMS:** If you experience COVID-19 symptoms while in quarantine, please report them to our Symptom Line during duty hours at 010-3658-0752. Symptoms include fever, chills, fatigue, body/muscle aches, sore throat, chest pain, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, cough, loss of taste or smell, congestion, runny nose, headache, nausea, vomiting, and/or diarrhea. For severe symptoms/emergencies call 119 from a Korean cellphone.

d **EMERGENCIES:** In the event of an emergency that requires you to evacuate your quarantine location, you should immediately evacuate and contact Gunsan Public Health at 063-463-4000 and your chain of command. You are not permitted to leave your quarantine location for any non-emergent reason. If you experience life threatening symptoms or injuries, immediately call 119 from a Korean cell phone and notify them of your quarantine status.

e **PHYSICAL DISTANCE:** You must maintain a minimum of six foot physical distance from any other person at all times when outside of your quarantine location. You may not have physical contact with or give items to non-quarantine personnel. You may be identified as a "Close Contact" during your travels, which means you were identified as having been within 6 feet of an individual that later tested positive.

f **OFF-BASE HEALTH MONITORING STATUS FOR FULLY VACCINATED MEMBERS: DO NOT LEAVE YOUR DOMICILE** until authorized by your squadron leadership (SQ/CC, SQ/DO, SQ/Supt, or SQ/First Sergeant). All DoD uniformed personnel, GS employees, Contractors, and all other individuals with SOFA-status arriving in South Korea that are fully vaccinated (14 days after completing a FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine series), to include individuals on Temporary Duty, may be released by their leadership to a Health Monitoring Status. Additional tests must be obtained on day 6/7 and Day 12. Further detailed ROEs for Health Monitoring Status will be provided to the applicable members by their leadership.

g **RELEASE:** Your release from Quarantine/Health Monitoring Status requires you to be symptom free on day 14 and have a final negative COVID-19 test. You will be released by your leadership or designated unit representative once they receive notification from 8 MDG.

h **DAY 6/7 & 12 TEST:** Prior to testing, please complete the DoD COVID-19 test questionnaire at <https://testing.mystatus.mil>. Report to the 8th Medical Group CONEX at 1630 on day 6/7 and 12 of quarantine for a COVID-19 test. Test collection occurs daily, to include weekends.

4. Procedures for the declaration of a Public Health Emergency (PHE), quarantine, and the actions prescribed above are found in Department of Defense (DoD) Instruction 6200.03, Public Health Emergency Management within the DoD, and AFI 10-2519, Public Health Emergencies and Incidents of Public Health Concern.

5. Any persons subject to quarantine have the right to contest the reason for quarantine. Information supporting an exemption or release can be provided through your chain of command for determination by the Installation Commander (or designated representative). The total time from submission to response will not exceed one duty day. Members will remain in quarantine during this process.

6. Violators of Quarantine/Health Monitoring Status orders can be charged with a crime. Service members may face administrative sanctions and/or criminal actions under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Civilian members, including dependents, may be punished in accordance with Service disciplinary rules and/or will be subject to administrative sanctions or removal.

7. A wide range of professionals are working hard to ensure you receive the highest quality medical care and are released from quarantine as soon as possible. These actions are necessary to safeguard the health of the Wolf Pack personnel and ensure the safety of the general public.

8. Stay connected and informed during quarantine using the contact information in the table below. If you ever have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact your sponsor, shirt, commander at any time. Additionally, you can reach Public Health during duty hours at 782-4509/4510.
