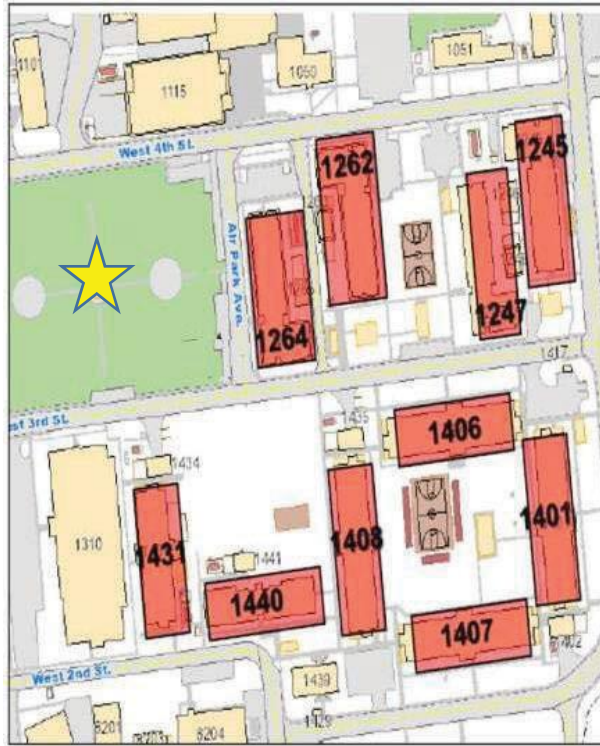

SUBJECT: 8 FW On-Base ROEs

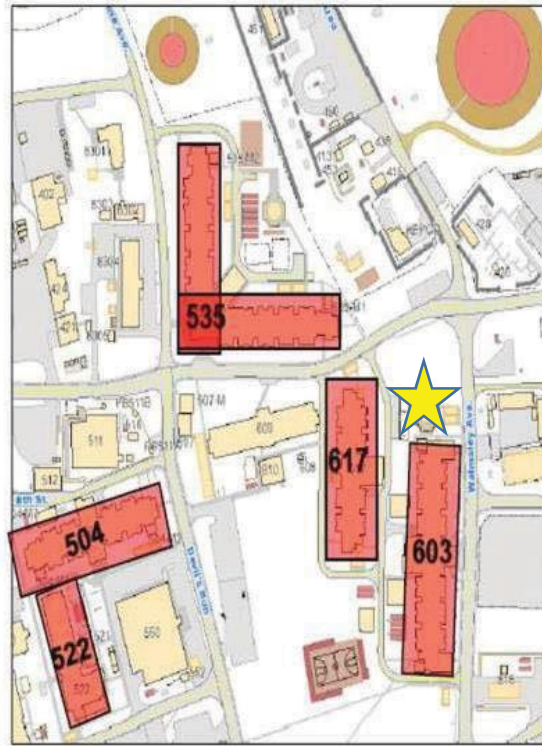
1. You are at elevated risk of exposure to COVID-19 due to travel before arriving to or while residing in South Korea. Therefore, I order you to comply with all quarantine requirements pursuant to my declaration of a Public Health Emergency as the Kunsan AB Installation Commander. Compliance with these requirements is necessary to ensure the safety and readiness of our force.
2. I order you to comply with the following quarantine requirements:
 - a. REPORT any illness or COVID-19 symptoms immediately to the COVID-19 Symptom Line during duty hours at 010-3658-0752 and the Nurse Advice Line (NAL) at 080-500-4011 after hours. If you are experiencing life threatening symptoms, please immediately call 911 or 063-470-0911 from a Korean cellphone.
 - b. DO NOT leave your quarantine location unless there is an immediate threat or concern to your life or safety. If there is any notification to evacuate your quarantine location (fire alarm, sirens, knocking on doors, etc), your immediate safety is the number one priority. All quarantine members should don their mask and reflective belt (if readily accessible), immediately evacuate the facility, and report to their designated quarantine emergency rally point (see attached map).
 - c. DO NOT have physical contact with any individuals. Maintain a minimum of 6 feet from all personnel.
 - d. STAY in your quarantine location. If you are not fully vaccinated, you will be quarantined until all release criteria are met. If you are fully vaccinated as determined by 8 MDG, you will be quarantined until your Initial/Day 1 COVID-19 test is confirmed negative and your leadership has officially released you to a Health Monitoring Status. Please refer to the Health Monitoring Status MFR for full details. DO NOT leave your quarantine quarters until instructed by your squadron leadership (SQ/CC, SQ/DO, SQ/Sup, or SQ First Sergeant). Fully vaccinated is defined as someone who is at least 14 days past an FDA authorized COVID-19 vaccine series.
3. This is a punitive order. During the Public Health emergency, violators of procedures, protocols, provisions, and/or orders detailed in this memorandum may be charged with a crime under Article 84, Breach of Medical Quarantine, Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ); Article 92, Failure to Obey an Order or Regulation, UCMJ; and/or 42 USC Section 241d, punished with a fine up to \$1,000, debarment from all USFK installations for two years, imprisonment for not more than one year, dishonorable discharge, and/or all of the above. This order is in effect to protect the force, to protect you, and to protect the mission.

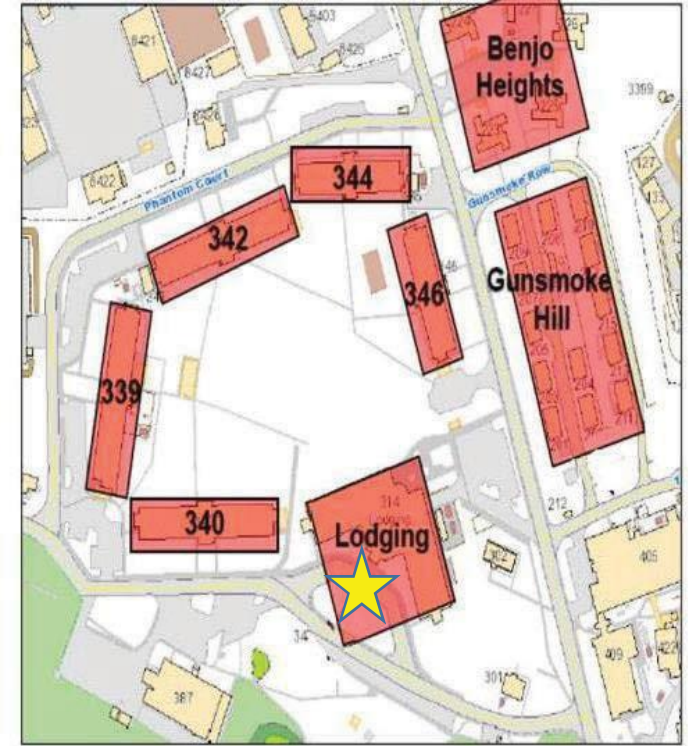
EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURES



1200 and 1400 blocks



500 and 600 blocks



300 block, lodging, Gunsmoke Hill and Benjo Heights

In the case of an emergency during your quarantine, the graphic above highlights the designated emergency rally points. Each grouping of buildings will have their own respective emergency rally location. Members should don their mask and reflective belt and immediately proceeded to their designated location. An 8 FW POC will be dispatched to take accountability and give further instructions.

- If you are quarantined in 1200/1400 blocks, your rally point is the gazebo in the center of the track.
- If you are quarantined in 500/600 blocks, your rally point is the smoke pit in-between Bldg 603 and Bldg 617.
- If you are quarantined in any officer dorm (including Benjo Heights and Gunsmoke Hill or the Wolf Pack lodge, your rally point is the circle drive outside the main lobby entrance of lodging .

MEMORANDUM FOR INDIVIDUALS SUBJECT TO MEDICAL QUARANTINE

FROM: 8 FW/PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY OFFICER (PHEO)

SUBJECT: Kunsan AB Medical Quarantine Guidance

1. In response to a declared public health emergency on Kunsan AB, Republic of Korea (ROK), by the 8th Fighter Wing Installation Commander, quarantine procedures have been implemented. There is concern that you were exposed and potentially infected with COVID-19 due to your recent travel.

2. Individual Quarantine information:

3. Rules of Engagement:

- a. **LOCATION:** You must proceed directly to your designated quarantine location. You may NOT leave your quarantine location unless immediate concern for your safety arises.
- b. **SYMPTOMS:** If you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 you must contact the Kunsan COVID-19 Symptom Line at 010-3658-0752 during duty hours. If you are having shortness of breath or an emergency, call 911 immediately. COVID-19 symptoms include, fever, chills, fatigue, body/muscle aches, sore throat, chest pain, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, cough, loss of taste or smell, congestion, runny nose, headache, nausea, vomiting, and/or diarrhea.

- c. **EMERGENCIES:** Call 911. If dialing from Lodging or Korean commercial phone dial:063-470- 0911; United States commercial phone dial: 011-82-6347-00911.
- d. **PHYSICAL DISTANCE:** You must maintain a minimum of six foot physical distance from any other person at all times when outside of your quarantine location. You may not have physical contact with or give items to non-quarantine personnel. You may be identified as a “Close Contact” during your travels, which means you were identified as having been within 6 feet of an individual that later tested positive.
- e. **DURATION:** You will be quarantined for a minimum of 14 days. The day you arrive in the ROK is considered Day 0 of quarantine. Day 1 of quarantine starts the day after arrival on the ROK (when you complete a full 24 hours in quarantine). For example, if you arrive to the ROK and receive this notification the night of 1 February (Day 0), 2 February is Day 1 of quarantine and your 14th day in quarantine would be 15 February 2021.
- f. **TEMP CHECKS:** Daily temperature and symptom self-monitoring will be done for all members in quarantine for 14 days.
- g. **HEALTH MONITORING STATUS FOR FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS: DO NOT LEAVE YOUR ROOM** until authorized by your squadron leadership (SQ/ CC, SQ/DO, SQ/Sup, or SQ First Sergeant) for Working Quarantine. All DoD uniformed personnel, GS employees, Contractors and all other individuals with SOFA-status arriving in South Korea that are fully vaccinated, to include individuals on Temporary Duty, may be released by their leadership to a “Health Monitoring Status” for 14 days. On day 6 and 12, fully vaccinated individuals will be required to take another COVID-19 test. After day 14, the individuals that have a negative test result may have the restrictions removed. Further detailed ROEs for “Health Monitoring Status” will be provided to applicable members after notification by leadership.
- h. **OUTDOOR TIME FOR NON-FULLY VACCINATED (QUARANTINE) MEMBERS: DO NOT LEAVE YOUR ROOM** until authorized by your squadron leadership (SQ/ CC, SQ/DO, SQ/Sup, or SQ First Sergeant) for outdoor time. Outdoor time may only be taken in designated areas as described below and AFTER an Initial/Day 1 negative COVID-19 test result. The daily maximum of outdoor time for exercise is 2 hours. No-movement hours for non-fully vaccinated members in quarantine are 0600-1000 and 1400-1800. These no- movement hours are in effect to reduce contact with non-quarantine members traveling to and from work as well as Wolf Pack Lodge staff. If you have not been contacted within 4 days of your Initial/Day 1 swab, please contact your sponsor and/or First Sergeant for updates. Quarantine members who are notified of authorized outdoor time will execute the following:

(1) You will wear a reflective belt across your waist when outside of your room as well as a mask or face cover that completely covers your mouth and nose. If you have not received a reflective belt within 24 hours of your arrival, please contact your sponsor or First Sergeant. The belt and mask must be worn prior to exiting your room and for the entire duration of the time outside of the room for non-fully vaccinated members.

(2) Quarantine personnel may only enter/exit their quarantine location through the designated doors and stairwells. These are designated by their facility’s Airmen Dorm Leader (ADL) or Lodging management.

(3) Only the courtyard/grassy area north of the Wolf Pack Lodge and the perimeter running trail on the west side of the installation are authorized for outdoor time (west side of

runway, along the fence line, extending down to Big Coyote). No other areas are authorized.

(4) **TRASH:** Personnel in Quarantine are responsible for taking out their trash to the designated quarantine dumpster during their “outdoor time”. You may not take out your trash until your day one test results come back and your leadership authorizes you for outdoor time. Members quarantined in a dormitory should contact their sponsor or ADL to find the closest quarantine dumpster. Members quarantined in lodging will use the quarantine dumpster across the street from lodging near the golf course and driving range.

(5) **LAUNDRY:** Personnel in Quarantine are able to do their laundry only during the designated times posted in their quarantine locations. You may **NOT** do laundry until your day one test results come back and your leadership authorizes you to leave your room for outdoor and laundry time. When doing laundry, ensure a minimum a 6 foot distance is maintained from other personnel and clean all contacted surfaces with disinfecting wipes after each use.

(6) **MOVEMENT LOG:** You must keep a movement log to include outdoor time, laundry, trash disposal, smoking outdoors, etc. You must track your locations and record room exit/return times.

(7) **TOBACCO USE:** The sole smoking location is behind Wolf Pack Lodge. Please see attached map. Sponsors and First Sergeants can contact Kunsan Pharmacy during duty hours at 782-5177 to request nicotine for their members.

i. **RELEASE:** Your release from Quarantine/Health Monitoring Status requires you to be symptom-free on day 14 and have a final negative COVID-19 test. You will be released by your leadership or designated unit representative once they receive notification from 8 Medical Group (MDG).

j. **DAY 12 TEST:** Prior to testing, please complete the DoD COVID-19 test questionnaire at <https://testing.mystatus.mil>. Report to the 8th Medical Group CONEX at 1630 on day 12 of quarantine for a COVID-19 test. Test collection occurs daily, to include weekends.

4. Procedures for the declaration of a PHE, quarantine, and the actions prescribed above are found in Department of Defense Instruction 6200.03, Public Health Emergency Management within the Department of Defense, and AFI 10-2519, Public Health Emergencies and Incidents of Public Health Concern.

5. Any persons subject to quarantine have the right to contest the reason for quarantine. Information supporting an exemption or release may be provided through your chain of command for determination by the Installation Commander (or designated representative). The total time from submission to response will not exceed 24 hours. Members will remain in quarantine during this process.

6. Violators of Quarantine/Health Monitoring Status orders can be charged with a crime. Service members may face administrative sanctions and/or criminal actions under the Uniform Code of Military Justice UCMJ. Civilian members, including dependents, may be punished in accordance with Service disciplinary rules and/or will be subject to administrative sanctions.

7. A wide range of professionals are working hard to ensure you receive the highest quality

medical care and are released from quarantine as soon as possible. These actions are necessary to safeguard the health of Wolfpack personnel and ensure the safety of the general public.
