

SUBJECT: 8 FW On Base Quarantine ROEs


- 1. You are at elevated risk of exposure to COVID-19 due to travel before arriving to, or while residing in South Korea. Therefore, I order you to comply with all quarantine requirements pursuant to my declaration of a public health emergency as the Kunsan AB Installation Commander. Compliance with these requirements is necessary to ensure the safety and readiness of our force.
- 2. I order you to comply with the following quarantine requirements:
- a. Stay in your quarantine location. You will be quarantined for at least 14 days and your release is conditional upon the appropriate negative COVID test results. DO NOT leave your quarantine quarters until instructed by your squadron leadership (SQ/CC, SQ/DO, SQ/Sup, or SQ First Sergeant).
- b. DO NOT LEAVE your quarantine location unless there is an immediate threat or concern to your life or safety. If there is any notification to evacuate your quarantine location (fire alarm, sirens, knocking on doors, etc), your immediate safety is the number one priority. All quarantine members should don their PPE (if readily accessible), immediately evacuate the facility, and report to their designated quarantine emergency rally point (see attached map).
  - c. DO NOT have physical contact with any individuals. Maintain a minimum of 6 feet from all personnel.
- d. Report any illness or COVID-19 symptoms immediately to the COVID-19 Advice Line during duty hours and the Nurse Advice Line (NAL) after hours. Symptoms include, fever, chills, fatigue, body/muscle aches, sore throat, chest pain, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, cough, loss of taste or smell, congestion, runny nose, headache, nausea, vomiting, and/or diarrhea. You can reach the COVID-19 Advice Line at 010-3658-0752 between the hours of 0800-1630L KST. If you are experiencing symptoms after duty hours, call the NAL at 080-500-4011. If you are experiencing life threatening symptoms, please immediately call 911 or 063-470-0911 from a Korean cellphone.
- 3. This is a punitive order. During the Public Health emergency, violators of procedures, protocols, provisions, and/or orders detailed in this memorandum may be charged with a crime under Article 84, Breach of Medical Quarantine, Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ); Article 92, Failure to Obey an Order or Regulation, UCMJ; and/or 42 USC Section 241d, punished with a fine up to \$1,000, debarment from all USFK installations for two years, imprisonment for not more than one year, dishonorable discharge, and/or all of the above. This order is in effect to protect the force, to protect you, and to protect the mission.

1200 and 1400 blocks


500 and 600 blocks

300 block, lodging, Gunsmoke Hill and Benjo Heights


In the case of an emergency during your quarantine, the graphic above highlights the designated emergency rally points. Each grouping of buildings will have their own respective emergency rally location. Members should don their PPE (mask and gloves), if readily available, and immediately proceeded to their designated location. An 8 FW POC will be dispatched to take accountability and give further instructions.

- If you are quarantined in 1200/1400 blocks, your rally point is the gazebo in the center of the track.
- If you are quarantined in 500 600 blocks, your rally point is the smoke pit in-between Bldg 603 and Bldg 617.
- If you are quarantined in any officer dorm (including Benjo Heights and Gunsmoke Hill) or the Wolf Pack lodge, your rally point is the circle drive outside the main lobby entrance of lodging.


#### TRASH PROCEDURES

# **Instructions**

- Quarantine members must take out their own trash. The proper PPE must be worn and times will be recorded in their movement log.
- Trash must be double bagged and sprayed down their trash with the bleach solution that will be left in front of the dumpsters for members to use.

#### MEMORANDUM FOR INDIVIDUALS SUBJECT TO MEDICAL QUARANTINE

FROM: 8 FW/PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY OFFICER (PHEO)

SUBJECT: Kunsan AB Medical Quarantine Guidance

1. In response to a declared public health emergency on Kunsan AB, Republic of Korea (ROK) by the 8th Fighter Wing Installation Commander, quarantine procedures have been implemented. There is concern that you were exposed and potentially infected with COVID-19 due to your recent travel.

#### 3. Rules of Engagement:

- a. LOCATION: You must proceed directly to your designated quarantine location. You may NOT leave your quarantine location unless immediate concern for your safety arises.
- b. EMERGENCIES: Call 911. If dialing from Lodging or Korean commercial phone dial: 063-470-0911, United States commercial phone dial: 011-82-6347-00911.

- c. CLOSE CONTACT: Due to public health concerns you cannot have close/physical contact with any other individuals except as approved by the installation PHEO. At all times, you must maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from all other individuals. Any close contact with any personnel MUST be reported to your chain of command.
- d. DURATION: You will be quarantined for a minimum of 14 days. The day you arrive in the ROK is considered Day 0 of quarantine. Day 1 of quarantine starts the day after arrival on the ROK (when you complete a full 24 hours in quarantine). For example, if you arrive to the ROK and receive this notification the night of 1 February (Day 0), 2 February is Day 1 of quarantine and your 14th day in quarantine would be 15 February 2021.
- e. TEMP CHECKS: Daily temperature and symptom checks will be done and logged on the provided Kunsan COVID-19 14-Day Self-Monitoring Symptom Log. Please take your temperature daily at 1000L.
- f. OUTDOOR TIME: **<u>DO NOT LEAVE YOUR ROOM</u>** until authorized by your squadron leadership (SQ/ CC, SQ/DO, SQ/Sup, or SQ First Sergeant) for outdoor time. Outdoor time may only be taken in designated areas as described below. If you are identified as a "close contact" to a confirmed COVID-19 positive person, you will **<u>NOT</u>** be authorized outdoor time during your quarantine. Outdoor time is only authorized for those that are not close contacts and AFTER an Initial/Day 1 negative COVID-19 test result. If you have not been contacted within 72 hours of your Initial/Day 1 swab, please contact your sponsor and/or First Sergeant for updates. Quarantine members who are notified of authorized outdoor time will execute the following:
  - (1) Maximum of 2 hours of outdoor time is authorized per day.
- (2) No movement hours for all members in quarantine: 0600-1000 and 1400-1800. These no movement hours are in effect to reduce contact with non-quarantine members traveling to and from work as well as Wolf Pack Lodge staff.
- (3) Members will wear gloves and a cloth or purchased face cover that completely covers the mouth and nose. The mask and gloves must be worn prior to exiting your room and for the entire duration of the time outside.
- (4) Members must not touch their face. If you sneeze/cough into the gloves, the gloves must be changed immediately.
- (5) Members may only enter/exit their quarantine location through the designated doors and stairwells. These are designated by their facility's Airmen Dorm Leader (ADL) or Lodging management.
- (6) Only the following locations are authorized for outdoor time (see map located in your Welcome Packet):
  - (a) Courtyard/grassy area north of the Wolf Pack Lodge.
- (b) Perimeter running trail on the west side of the installation (west side of runway, along the fence line, extending down to Big Coyote).

- (c) ALL other areas NOT authorized during outdoor time.
- (7) You must maintain a minimum of six foot physical distance from any other person at all times when outside of your quarantine location.
- (a) TRASH: Quarantined members are responsible for taking out their trash to the designated quarantine dumpster during their "outdoor time". You may <u>not</u> take out your trash until your day one test results come back and your leadership authorizes you for outdoor time. Members quarantined in a dormitory should contact their sponsor and ADL to find the closest quarantine dumpster. Members quarantined in lodging will use the quarantine dumpster across the street from lodging near the golf course and driving range.
- (b) LAUNDRY: Quarantine members are able to do their laundry only during the designated times posted in their quarantine locations. You may <u>not</u> do laundry until your day one test results come back and your leadership authorizes you to leave your room for outdoor and laundry time.
- (c) CLOSE CONTACTS TRASH/LAUNDRY: Close contacts may judiciously take out their trash but no more frequently than once every three days. Close contacts are encouraged to only launder their clothing if absolutely necessary and no more than once every seven days. When doing laundry, members must adhere to posted laundry times for their quarantine location, ensure a minimum of six feet distance is maintained from all other personnel, and clean all contacted surfaces with disinfecting wipes after each use.
- g. MOVEMENT LOG: You must keep a movement log to include outdoor time, laundry, trash disposal, smoking outdoors, etc. You must track your locations and record room exit/return times.
- h. SYMPTOMS: If you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 you must contact the Kunsan COVID-19 Symptom Line at 010-3658-0752 during duty hours. If you are having shortness of breath or an emergency, call 911 immediately. COVID-19 symptoms include: fever, chills, fatigue, body/muscle aches, sore throat, chest pain, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, cough, new loss of taste, new loss of smell, congestion, runny nose, headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea. IAW the 7 AF/CC Memorandum, please also notify the Kunsan Public Health Flight at DSN 782-4509/4510, commercial +83-0505-782-4509/4510
- i. TOBACCO USE: The sole smoking location is behind Wolf Pack Lodge. Please see attached map. Nicotine can be substituted in the form of a patch or gum upon request. Sponsors and First Sergeants can contact Public Health during duty hours at 782-4509/45100 to request nicotine for their members.
- j. DAY 12 TEST: At 1630 on day 12 of quarantine, you will report to 8 Medical Group (MDG) Medical CONEX for a COVID-19 test. Please see attached map.
  - (1) You MUST wear mask and gloves during transit.
- (2) Do NOT report to the CONEX if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms. If you have COVID-19 symptoms contact the Kunsan Covid Symptom Line at 010-3658-0752.

- k. RELEASE: Your release from quarantine requires you to be symptom free on day 14 and have a final negative COVID-19 test. You will be released from quarantine by your leadership or designated unit representative once they receive notification from 8 MDG clearing you from quarantine. You WILL NOT come out of quarantine until instructed by your squadron leadership (SQ/CC, SQ/DO, SQ/Sup, or SQ First Sergeant).
- 4. Procedures for the declaration of a PHE, quarantine, and the actions prescribed above are found in Department of Defense Instruction 6200.03, Public Health Emergency Management Within the Department of Defense, and AFI 10-2519, Public Health Emergencies and Incidents of Public Health Concern. Procedures for the declaration of a PHE, quarantine, and the actions prescribed above are found in DoD and Air Force policy individuals working on, residing on, or visiting military
- 5. Any persons subject to quarantine have the right to contest the reason for quarantine. Information supporting an exemption or release can be provided to me or one of my designated representatives, who will provide the information to the Installation Commander (or designated representative) for final determination. The total time from submission to response will not exceed 24 hours. Members will remain in quarantine during this process.
- 6. IAW the 7 AF/CC Memorandum, violators of quarantine orders can be charged with a crime. Service members may face administrative sanctions and/or criminal actions under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Civilian members, including dependents, may be punished in accordance with Service disciplinary rules and/or will be subject to administrative sanctions.
- 7. A wide range of professionals are working hard to ensure you receive the highest quality medical care and are released from quarantine as soon as possible. These actions are necessary to safeguard the health of Wolfpack personnel and ensure the safety of the general public.
- 8. RESOURCES: Stay connected and informed during quarantine using the contact information in the table below.
