PRIOR TO PCS



ATTENTION

Coordinate with your unit/supervision prior to your departure to confirm your arrival

- ◆ Leadership from gaining unit will reach out to the losing unit's commander, superintendent or first sergeant at least 30 days in advance (if possible)
- Unit sponsor will contact the inbound member, explain the arrival process, quarantine and ensure constant communication with inbound member

Please utilize the COVID-19 Sponsor Checklist located on the Kunsan AB COVID-19 SharePoint

- Flight itinerary is received from losing base and forwarded to gaining unit sponsor for LRS and quarantine coordination



Starting September 1, 2021, all DoD Civilians, Contractors and Family Members, traveling to the Republic of Korea must have a valid visa or an approved Korea - Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) prior to entering the country, unless already in possession of a valid Korean visa. The entry requirements for Service Members on official travel (PCS, TDY, etc.) will remain the same, using the Common Access Card and travel orders.

What is a K-ETA? The K-ETA is an electronic travel authorization that visa-free eligible foreign visitors need to obtain before entering Korea, by submitting an application with relevant information online.

You must apply for the K-ETA at least 24 hours prior to boarding a flight or ship bound for Korea. There is a 10,000 KRW (approximately \$9-\$10 USD) non-refundable fee that must be paid, even if the application is denied. You can apply at: https://www.k-eta.go.kr/portal/apply/index.do.

To complete the K-ETA application use the US Embassy address: Address Line 1 – 188 Sejong-daero, Jongro-gu, Seoul, Korea 03141 Address Line 2 – [installation of assignment... i.e. Camp Humphreys, Osan Air Base, etc.]

The K-ETA is valid for 2 years from the date of approval and allows you to travel to Korea, but does not guarantee entry. The final determination of entry will be made by the immigration official during the immigration process.

K-ETA application by proxy is available, meaning one person can apply for up to 30 people and make the total payment at once.




New arrivals will be escorted to a special gate area, given a mask and gloves, and screened with a temperature check and questionnaire

IN-PROCESSING & SUSTAINMENT



- ◆ Meal Pick Up: Unit representatives will retrieve meals from the O'Malley Dining Facility, 3x/day and deliver to members in quarantine. Members in quarantine are eligible to receive government meals without charge. The base also has food delivery services, visit ShopMyExchange.com for information.
- ◆ Trash: Per Republic of Korea procedures, trash will be considered contaminated until member is cleared from quarantine. Trash removal will depend on quarantine location. *Refer to notes for more information*.
- ◆ Laundry: Members in quarantine may utilize laundry rooms every Tuesday and Thursday between 1300-1600.
- ◆ Recreation: Members are authorized up to two hours of outdoor time per day. Members will wear gloves and a face cover prior to exiting their room and for the duration of their time outside. Refer to notes for more information.
- ◆ Mail: Members in quarantine may designate an individual to pick up their mail. A PS Form 3801 (available on the Kunsan AB COVID-19 SharePoint) must be completed.
- ◆ **General Support:** Members should reach out to the sponsor/unit for all other needs.
- Quarantine Release: On day 13, medical personnel will visit members for a COVID test. If the test is negative, the member must be contacted by chain of command before being released from quarantine.

Current inbounds do not have an opportunity to buy a Korean SIM card or WiFi upon arrival.

For connectivity in your dorm room, coordinate with your sponsor prior to arrival.

STAY MENTALLY & PHYSICALLY FIT

Maintain a daily routine and keep a list of goals or tasks! Do at home exercises to relieve stress and elevate your mood. Play games or complete puzzles.

PRACTICE PROPER SLEEP HYGIENE

Try to keep consistent sleep and wake times to optimize sleep quality and restfulness.

Create a good sleep environment, block out noise and light.

STAY CONNECTED

Use "distant socializing" - engaging with friends, family and peers despite physical distancing precautions.

BE MINDFUL OF WHAT YOU INGEST

Both physically (food, nutrients, etc.) and mentally (news, rumors, attitudes, negative thoughts, etc.).
