REMARKS		
<p>IAW FRAGO 86 to USFK Operation Order 20-19 the 8 FW Installation Commander is implementing the following guidance:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Effective immediately, all fully vaccinated 8 FW affiliated personnel (which includes military members, civilians, contractors, and tenant units on Kunsan AB) are no longer required to wear a mask on USFK installations located within a geographic boundary that has a 7-Day Cumulative Incidence Rate of less than 50 cases per 100,000 person. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Mask wear is required in the following facilities regardless of incidence rate and vaccination status: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Correctional facilities. ii. Health care settings including DoD military medical, dental, and veterinary treatment facilities. b. Mask wear is required for all 8 FW-affiliated personnel under health monitoring status. 2. Mask wear remains mandatory for all 8 FW affiliated personnel, regardless of vaccination status at all indoor settings on USFK installations that are located within a geographic boundary that has a 7-Day Cumulative Incidence Rate greater than or equal to 50 cases per 100,000 persons. 3. All non-vaccinated 8 FW personnel must wear a mask inside all DoD installation facilities at all times. 4. Prior to any travel, it is the responsibility of the member to be aware of the destinations current 7-Day Cumulative Incidence rate to ensure adherence to USFK policy. 5. This order is issued pursuant to my authority as the installation commander and my continuing declaration of a Public Health Emergency (PHE). Any military member who refuses to obey this order and its restrictions may be subject to punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Those not subject to military law who refuse to obey or otherwise violate the foregoing restrictions may be denied installation access or be barred from the installation for a period up to two years.
