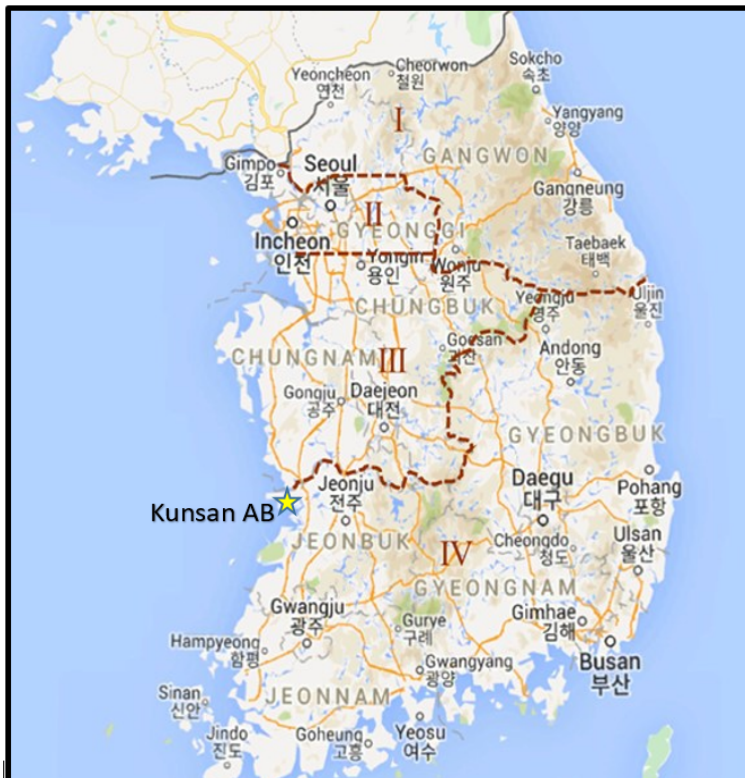

<b>REMARKS</b>		
<p>1. Beginning <b>15 February, 2021 Areas I, III, IV and the Seongnam District (K-16) will have transitioned to HPCON Bravo.</b> Area II remains in HPCON Charlie until further notice. It is critical that all members of the Wolf Pack remain vigilant and continue to adhere to the guidelines outlined in this directive. This SSD covers approved activities and travel within HPCON Bravo (see graphic 1 below for Map of ROK Areas). This guidance is IAW USFK OPERATION ORDER 20-19 FRAGO 63. This SSD supersedes SSD 21-1 Change 4 signed <b>6 February, 2021.</b></p> <p>2. In order to protect the Pack, this directive must be followed by all military personnel, family members, US and Korean National civilian employees, DoD contractors, retirees, and any other persons with access to Kunsan Air Base. While on-base, unless mission requirements dictate otherwise, members must wear their masks BOTH indoors and outdoors when 6 feet of spacing cannot be maintained. Required indoor mask wear locations include but are not limited to all on bases services, work centers, and other high traffic areas.</li> <li>b. While off-base, mask wear is mandatory at all times unless participating in an outdoor activity that permits 6 feet between participants (ie. Running, Hiking, Biking). As of 13 October 2020, any person found off base not wearing an appropriate mask may be fined up to 100,000 won (approximately \$87) by the ROK government.</li> <li>c. See SSD 21-2 Change 2, 18 December 2020, for more information on mask wear both on and off installation.</li> </ol> <p>4. Self-Monitoring - Feeling sickly? Leave quickly! <b>(GO HOME, DO NOT GO TO THE MEDICAL CLINIC)</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Personnel identifying as sick will immediately return to their residence and contact the Kunsan COVID Symptom line at 010-3658-0752 during duty hours.</li> <li>b. For after hour care or immediate life threatening medical emergencies dial 911.</li> <li>c. In order to aid Public Health with contact tracing in the event of a positive case, all members must keep a detailed 14-day log, which will include locations, dates, and durations of visits.</li> <li>d. In the event a member tests positive for COVID-19, they will be transported to Osan AB for isolation. Members should reference the recommended "Go Bag " packing list on Kunsan's SharePoint (<a href="https://kunsan.eis.pacaf.af.mil/8FW/COVID-19/SitePages/Home.aspx">https://kunsan.eis.pacaf.af.mil/8FW/COVID-19/SitePages/Home.aspx</a>) under the Wolf Pack Guidance tab, CoQ/Quarantine docs folder.</li> </ol> <p>5. <b>On-Base Activities:</b> All on-base U.S. facilities and services are open. Although there is no maximum capacity for services, social distancing and mask wear must be adhered to at all times. Saunas and steam rooms at on base/post facilities are off limits until further notice.</p> <p>6. <b>Off-Base Activities:</b> Bars and clubs remain off limits and are defined as any establishment whose primary purpose is to serve alcohol or requires patrons to be 19 years of age. <b>Effective 15 February, 2021, saunas, public bathhouses, gyms, fitness facilities, martial arts classes, aerobic classes, dance classes, internet cafes, karaoke, and singing or music lessons are authorized in Areas I, III, and IV. Bars, clubs, and large gatherings remain restricted IAW USFK and local ROK policies.</b></p>		

7. **On Peninsula Travel:** Leisure travel within Areas I, III, IV, including Jeju Island, is authorized. Leisure travel to the Seongnam District for HPCON Bravo activities is not authorized. *Members traveling to Seongnam District must assume HPCON Charlie protocols.*
  - a. Exceptions to these restrictions for official duties may be waived by the first O-6 in the member's chain of command.
    - i. Travel through Area 2 with the purpose of transiting yourself or another member to Incheon Airport is authorized travel in this region. If overnight lodging is required in Area 2, a waiver is required by the first O-6 in the member's chain of command.
    - ii. As of 15 February, 2021, there will be no restrictions on bubble to bubble travel to **Youngsan Garrison**. All other on peninsula installations remain unrestricted. Members may also visit the areas directly outside unrestricted USFK installations (i.e. Songtan Entertainment District SED), so long as all HPCON guidance for that region is followed.
    - iii. USFK continually monitors COVID-19 conditions on the peninsula and will reevaluate assessments as required. Reference <https://www.usfk.mil> for the most current HPCON conditions and travel restrictions.
  - b. Public transportation is authorized only within **HPCON Bravo locations**. Members are encouraged to use caution and must wear their masks at all times. The use of public transportation is **prohibited in areas with HPCON Charlie restrictions**.
  - c. Members are permitted to stay at accommodations on or off base (hotels, family/friends' homes, campsites) in Area IV. Members are not permitted to stay off USFK installations in all other areas IAW HPCON Charlie restrictions.
8. **Off Peninsula Travel:** Travel outside of the Republic of Korea is authorized IAW the 8 FW Leave Policy.
9. **This order is issued pursuant to my authority as the installation commander and my declaration of a Public Health Emergency (PHE). Any military member who refuses to obey this order and its restrictions may be subject to punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ). Those not subject to military law who refuse to obey or otherwise violate the foregoing restrictions may be denied installation access or be barred from the installation for a period up to two years.**
