REMARKS		
<p>1. Quarantine is defined as the separation and restriction of a person who has a heightened risk of having been exposed to COVID-19. International arrivals to Kunsan AB will be placed in either quarantine or Health Monitoring Status IAW SSD 21-3, "COVID-19 Terms and Definitions."</p> <p>2. Testing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Day 1/Initial test: All personnel require an initial COVID-19 test as described in SSD 21-5. Personnel will not be authorized outdoor time or initiation of Health Monitoring Status until this test results negative and they have been notified of privileges by their leadership. b. Day 6-7/Intermediate test: Only personnel in Health Monitoring Status require a test on Day 6-7. c. Day 12/Final test: All personnel require a test on Day 12 to be released from quarantine. d. Intermediate and final tests are conducted daily at 1630 in the 8 Medical Group (MDG) Medical CONEX for a COVID-19 test. Prior to arrival, members must complete the DoD COVID-19 test questionnaire at https://testing.mystatus.mil. e. Do NOT report to the CONEX if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms. If you have COVID-19 symptoms contact the Kunsan COVID-19 Symptom Line at 010-3658-0752. <p>3. Quarantine Rules of Engagement - Non fully vaccinated personnel:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Non fully vaccinated personnel must wear a reflective belt and face mask at all times when outside of their room. These assist in ensuring 6-foot separation from the base populace and effective source control. b. Non fully vaccinated personnel must use only the doors and stairwells that have been designated. c. Non fully vaccinated personnel are authorized a maximum of 2 hours outdoor time daily and must not leave their rooms during the hours of 0600L-1000L and 1400L-1800L. d. When utilizing outdoor time, non fully vaccinated personnel must use the most direct route to a designated exercise location. There are only two authorized locations for outdoor time at Kunsan AB: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Courtyard/grassy area north of the Wolf Pack Lodge ii. Perimeter running trail on the west side of the installation (west side of runway, along the fence line, extending down to Big Coyote)

4. **Health Monitoring Status Rules of Engagement - Fully vaccinated personnel:**
 - a. Fully vaccinated personnel may exit their domiciles and enter Health Monitoring Status after receiving a negative Day-1 COVID-19 test, submission of an approved Quarantine Action Plan and formal release by their chain of command.
 - b. Fully vaccinated personnel are not required to don a reflective belt or mask except in specially designated areas such as the 8 Medical Group Clinic.
5. **Off-Base Personnel:** Personnel choosing to quarantine off-base must be transported from Kunsan AB to their off-base quarantine location either by: 1) a pre-staged vehicle for the quarantined individual; 2) a family member planning to quarantine with the inbound personnel; 3) a government/contracted vehicle with driver and other passengers wearing approved PPE. **Unit/Sponsor pick-ups or taking public transportation IS NOT authorized from Incheon International Airport or Osan AB.**
 - a. Quarantine: Non fully vaccinated personnel quarantining off base may NOT leave their residence for any reason except emergencies and to report for COVID-19 testing.
 - b. Health Monitoring Status: Fully vaccinated personnel may engage in authorized activities IAW the Kunsan AB Health Monitoring Status Procedures MFR dated 6 July 2021.
 - c. All individuals choosing to quarantine off-base must complete a Quarantine Action Plan. A template is available on the COVID-19 Sharepoint.
6. **Release from Quarantine:** Members will only be released from quarantine or Health Monitoring Status when their Day-12 COVID-19 test returns as negative and are COVID-19 symptom-free after 14 days. Members will be notified by their leadership or designated unit representative once they have been cleared by the 8 MDG.
